[Extract of the Promoter's contract between the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme & Infront Moto Racing]



PROMOTER'S CONTRACT











COUNTRY: SWITZERLAND

This agreement made the 7th day of February, 2026, BY AND BETWEEN

1. Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM), A governing body for motorcycle sport, headquartered at Mies, Switzerland, represented herein by Jorge Viegas (hereinafter referred to as "FIM")

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AND

2. Infront Moto Racing, a company incorporated in Monaco, 183 : 28002 MONACO (hereinafter referred to as "Infront Moto Racing")

WHEREAS

a. Pursuant to various agreements, the parties acknowledge that the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) holds exclusive regulatory authority over motorcycle racing events worldwide. The FIM is empowered to establish and enforce rules, regulations, and standards governing the conduct of such events, including those covered by this contract. Parties agree to abide by all FIM regulations and standards applicable to the events outlined herein, and to cooperate fully with the FIM in its regulatory efforts. Any disputes regarding the interpretation or application of FIM regulations shall be resolved through the mechanisms established by the FIM. Parties further acknowledge that the FIM's decisions regarding regulatory matters are final and binding. In pursuance of the same, the parties hereby agree to the following clauses:









1. Infront Moto Racing will promote the Event and Infront Moto Racing will arrange for no less than thirteen motorcycles with 13 riders of an acceptable standard in the MotoGP[™] class, Moto2[™] class and/or Moto3[™] class respectively to take part in the Event on the date set out in the official FIM MotoGP World Championship. Calendar in the years 2026, 2026, 2027, 2028 and 2030, in accordance with FIM's Moto Racing Manual and the Series Regulations. Regulations which Infront Moto Racing, expressly recognize, have received, examined and understood.

- 2. In consideration of the foregoing Infront Moto Racing warrant as follows:
 - i. that they have the sole and exclusive rights, subject only to any conditions that have already been notified in writing to the FIM to promote the Event in each year during the term; that they are in sole and exclusive possession of all the required rights, permits, licenses and consents relating to the Circuit upon which the Event is to be held.

3. Infront Moto Racing Sports agrees to maintain accurate, complete, and timely financial records in accordance with internationally recognized accounting standards, including but not limited to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) or International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), with respect to the following:

- a. Infront Moto Racing Sports shall provide the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) with regular financial reports of each proposed Grand Prix circuit prior to 12 months from the date of the event, alongside balance sheets, income statements, cash flow statements, and any other relevant financial documents, on a quarterly basis or as otherwise requested by the FIM.
- b. The FIM reserves the right to conduct audits or reviews of Infront Moto Racing Sports' financial records and operations, either directly or through designated third-party auditors, to verify compliance with contractual obligations and financial reporting standards.










4. Infront Moto Racing Sports acknowledges and agrees to comply with all rules, regulations, directives, and standards established by the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) governing the conduct of MotoGP events, including but not limited to technical specifications, safety protocols, sporting conduct rules, and event organization guidelines, extending to:

- a. Informing the FIM of any changes to its operations, policies, procedures, or practices that may impact compliance with FIM regulations. This includes modifications to event management procedures, technical requirements, safety protocols, or any other aspect relevant to MotoGP events.
- b. Collaborating with the FIM in the development and implementation of regulatory measures, providing input, feedback, and cooperation as necessary to ensure the effective enforcement and application of FIM regulations.

5. The Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) hereby authorizes Infront Moto Racing to enter into promoter agreements with circuit hosts for MotoGP events as outlined in the Grand Prix calendar for the specified period of 2026-2030:

- a. Granted the exclusive right to negotiate, execute, and manage promoter agreements with circuit hosts selected for inclusion in the MotoGP Grand Prix calendar. These promoter agreements shall govern the hosting and organization of MotoGP events at the respective circuits.
- b. Ensure that all promoter agreements entered into with circuit hosts comply with the standards, regulations, and guidelines established by the FIM for MotoGP events. This includes but is not limited to technical specifications, safety protocols, sporting conduct rules, and event
- c. organization standards.
- d. Shall be responsible for negotiating financial arrangements with circuit hosts, including but not limited to venue rental fees, revenue sharing arrangements, sponsorship agreements, and ticket sales arrangements.

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


Dear Mr. Lorenzo,
